TOWN OF MARION REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING JANUARY 9, 2024

The Town of Marion's Board of Aldermen met Tuesday, January 9, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. at the Marion Fire Station for their regular business meeting. Members present included: Mayor Danny A. Smith, Aldermen Mark Andrews, Bubba Hoggatt and Erik Redd. Guests included Assistant Clerk Cheryl Geoghagan, Chief of Police Montral Ferguson and Water Superintendent Jimmy Caldwell. Alderwoman Rhonda Davis and Alderman Channing Washington were absent. Mayor Smith called the meeting to order. Chief Ferguson gave the invocation and Eric Redd led the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Smith opened the floor for public comments. There being no comments, Mayor Smith closed the public comments session.

On motion by Alderman Andrews, seconded by Alderman Redd to pay bills. Motion carried.

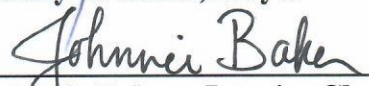
