RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Eric Redd has submitted his resignation as Alderman of the Town of Marion, Parish of Union, State of Louisiana, effective January 29, 2024 and it has been accepted by the Board of Alderman, and

WHEREAS, His resignation has caused a vacancy in office and an election must be ordered and called to fill the unexpired term of office exceeding one year: and

WHEREAS, the governing authority of Marion, Louisiana, is given the authority and responsibility under the provisions of La. R.S. 18:602 to appoint a person to fill the vacancy who meet the qualifications of the office, and to call a special election to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Marion, Louisiana, at a Special Called Meeting convened, resolved that William Lum Farr be appointed to fill the Alderman position until a special election can be held to fill the vacancy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the special election be called and held with the special Primary election date set for November 5, 2024 and the special General election date set for December 7, 2024 with qualifying dates set for July 17 and 18, 2024.

By motion of Alderman Eugene "Bubba" Hoggatt, duly seconded by Alderman Rhonda Davis the above resolution was adopted by the following vote on this 14th day of February, 2024.
