The Town of Marion's Board of Aldermen met on Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Marion Fire Station for a Special Business Meeting. Members present included Mayor Danny A. Smith, Alderwomen Rhonda Davis & Tina Harris, Alderman Mark Andrews. Guests included the Chief of Police Montral Ferguson, Water Superintendent Jimmy Caldwell & Former Clerk Johnnie Baker.
